Courage Ride Impact

- Honors Seth Bailey, who passed away from Sarcoma in 2003, and others who have fought Sarcoma
- Founded in 2005 by Jackie & Tom Bailey, parents of Seth
- Proceeds support the U of I Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center Sarcoma Research Program
- Over the past 19 years, Courage Ride has donated over \$865,000 for Sarcoma cancer research
- Since 2005, those dollars have seeded numerous Sarcoma research grants, many leading to larger Sarcoma research projects and supports one of the largest Sarcoma research tissue banks in the Midwest
- UIHC is the only comprehensive cancer center in the state that treats the vast majority of sarcomas





About Sarcoma Cancer

- Diverse and rare group of malignant tumors that develop in soft tissue and bone
- In over 30 years, little change in survivorship and diagnoses cases
- Each year, over 13,000 adults and children are diagnosed in the United States with Sarcoma and over 5,000 will die
- Over 100 lowa children, young adults and adults are diagnosed each year

About Sarcoma Cancer

- Although it is a relatively rare disease, it is very important to all types of cancer research
- Researching rare cancers such as sarcoma often leads to breakthroughs in general cancer research
- While cancer is among the costliest diseases in the nation, funding for cancer research has been shrinking over the past decade, according to the American Association for Cancer Research
- Sarcoma receives 1 to 2 percent of all cancer research funding
- Much of the discovery and research in sarcoma has to come from philanthropic efforts like Courage Ride.
